

## Kindergarten Supply List 2017-2018

### Each student should bring to school:

- Send \$7 for notebooks purchased through school
- 1 large backpack (no bags on rollers)
- 1 change of clothes (Label with your child's name and place in a plastic zip-loc bag. Does not need to be uniform but should be grey or navy.)
- A small blanket and tiny pillow for nap (A crib blanket is a great size; must fit in a 1 cubic foot square.)
- Art smock. (The best smocks are old, adult sized t-shirts with the child's first and last name printed clearly in 3 inch letter in permanent marker across the chest. Ideally, the smock should come to the child's knees and elbows.)
- 3 heavy duty plastic two-pocket folders (Solid color, not with a character on them.) Please label them with student's name and these subjects: Classwork, Homework, Spanish and Character Ed. (1 folder shared)
- 2-12 packs of #2 pencils (yellow only)
- 3 large pink erasers (not pencil toppers)
- 1 pack of construction paper
- 5 thin/fine-tip Expo brand dry erase markers
- 5 Glue sticks
- 1 box of Kleenex tissues or roll of paper towels
- Hand sanitizer (Alcohol-free only)
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 1 roll of clear contact paper

\*Please write your child's name and class on coats and uniforms. You do not need to label other items as they will be shared with the class.\*

### Each child should have the following for use at home:

- A box of 24 crayons
- 1 metal-bladed school scissor (Fiskars children's scissors work well)

### Please choose 1-2 of the items below to donate to the class:

- 1 box of Band-Aids
- Storage bags (sandwich & quart size-zipper close)
- Clear sheet protectors

If you have them, we could always use: gently used books, games, puzzles, clothespins, post-its, tape, cotton balls, beads, sequins, stickers, favors for prize box, etc.
